


XIV. **RCM Report** The South Florida Region met on March 19-20 in the Midcoast Area. During the RSC, it was reported by the admin committee that in researching past minutes, a motion had been adopted over three years ago which made it so that all policy motions were to go back to the groups for a vote. Therefore, there are four motions that will need to be voted on, three of which are policy motions. These motions will be enclosed as a separate attachment. Be advised that there is one motion which is three pages long, but is basically a simple motion. The motion would place the duties of the Regional Activities Committee under the PR Committee. The remainder of the motion just shows all the policies that need to be removed, changed or transferred over to the PR section of the policy.

To open the Living Clean pdf file, a password is required, this is the password: WSC2012. The password needs to be entered two separate times. Also, the file is protected against printing and editing, but is available for those with accessibility issues.

The item noted in bold are the instructions that came from NA World Services. I have sent them a letter asking why these are not allowed to be printed at this time, since it will be in the Conference Agenda Report in November and printable at that time. I have gotten a "cracked" file of the Living Clean book that would allow it to be printed, but I don't feel I can distribute it until such time as I've received a response from World Service. So, more will be revealed.

Another attachments to our ASC minutes are the latest Service System Proposals, These are the revisions made by World Services as a result of the latest from the workgroup they created. These will be, most likely, the final revisions until the World Service Conference next year. At that time, we can expect to have to vote on whether we believe these new ideas are something we feel they should continue working on or if they should be scrapped. Everyone should review these proposals since it would drastically change the service structure as we know it now.

The other item of interest going on in various areas in the fellowship is the issue of a United States Service Conference. This is a movement that is currently being proposed by certain members throughout the US fellowship. They met in Wichita, Kansas at the beginning of March. Our region sent our RD to bring back information from that meeting. This gathering is asking that groups vote on certain proposals. At this time, I'm not sure what this area wants me to do about this, so I will bring this up at the next ASC meeting for direction, because I don't know what y'all want me to do with information resulting from a meeting of members which, at this point is just a bunch of members and not an existing service body.

The next RSC will be held in Ft Myers on May 14-15. We will be requesting funds at the next ASC from our Treasurer for travel and hotel costs for that weekend as per ASC policy.
