

- A point was brought up about the original source of the funds, which was from South Broward ASC. A few areas ago quorum was lost and business was unable to be taken care of. Money that was to be used for bus ads ended up being donated to Region due to our policy of donating money to region before it occurs. South Broward ASC then asked for the money back from region, and they re-donated the money towards the project. In essence it was originally South Broward ASC's funds.

[GROUPS] MOTION 01-10-10 Maker: Helpline Committee Second: Negative Thoughts

To remove all policy about 12 step lists. INTENT: To remove risk to the addicts who give rides, and risk to our area, as well the sign up for the 12 step list has been unsuccessful

- This is a policy change so must go back to groups. Attached to the motion was a list of places where the words: 12 STEP LIST is to be removed. The discussion was passionate as the main points were 1.) the unsuccessful attempt to organize people to sign up on the sheet. 2.) The insurance risk as area is only covered within the meeting environments and once moves out of that setting, we as an area may be liable if any mishaps occur to be sued etc. 3.) The point is not to discourage this type of service, but simply to REMOVE THE VERBAGE from policy. No one is currently maintaining the list, as well the removal would take the liability on the area.
