**Open Forum:**

PR tried to contact officials at Susan B. Anthony and were unsuccessful. It appears they have hired someone new and we will meet with this new person. Barry will call Monday to make an appointment and 4 PR reps will attend.

**Public Relations:**

- We are helping out for Regional Events like the one on August 14 and 15, 2010 at Don Shula's, it is a PR and Helpline learning event.

Shift Sheets were reviewed.

**Old Business:**

- Yo Frank gave us information on adds inside Broward County buses: if we print 25 adds, it is \$10 per add. For over 100, \$7.50. To put them up, it is \$10 for every card for 4 weeks or \$7.50 for 3 months. For example, if we put 25 adds for 3 months, the total cost is \$1,000, including printing. For 50 cards, it would be \$1,900 for 3 months. As the buses run in Gold Coast and South Atlantic, Barry will ask if they are interested in participating. Yo Frank will also find out what happens if the adds are vandalized and if we get them back after the we stop advertising;
- Marie reports on bus benches: the signs cost \$150 to make, they are 2x6 feet. If we run 5 adds, it costs \$125 per bench per month. So to get started, we need \$1,250 for the adds to run for one month. We do not get to choose the locations, the advertising company does. The signs are replaced for free if vandalized and are ours to keep when add time is over.

We voted on both options and the group has decided to pursue the adds inside buses for the time being.

**AD HOC Subcommittee -** Greetings,

On Tuesday January 5, 2010 Barry S. , Sue F. and myself met with the Dr. Melina Goldenberg (clinical Director), and Sue Armstrong (client director). Overall the reception we received was very positive, we were able to get right down to the solutions. We presented the concerns that were brought up at our previous meeting and we began to work on solutions. Both Dr. Goldenberg and Sue Armstrong were not aware that the clients were being left without supervision and agreed that that would be addressed . We also came up with the following solutions.

1. SBA will try to split up groups of clients over different meetings so one meeting isn't overwhelmed with clients and children.
2. Barry S. and Dave L. will send a list of suggested meeting places where the rooms are larger and can more likely accommodate the clients
3. SBA is currently working on trying to get volunteers to baby sit the children, but are currently prohibited by DCF to allow anyone without being approved DCF to care for the children. This even prohibits other clients in the facility to watch children other than their own.
4. Public Relations members will put a presentation on for the clients on meetings and the importance of the atmosphere of recovery.
5. Public information members will also put on a presentation for the staff.

This concluded the work of the Ad Hoc committee. Since I am a member of Public Relations committee, I will continue to work closely with the Chair to develop the presentations for SBA clients and staff. ILS Dave L
